2. *Individual Profile*

Individual profile may include background research, motivation, multilingual proficiency, undergraduate institution, presentations, interviews, work experience, demonstrated commitment to a particular field of study, community involvement, and family and socioeconomic background. Limit of 250 words. Must be double spaced. Place your individual profile and three letters of recommendation in a brown manila envelope.

3. *Letters of Recommendation*

Three letters of recommendation on *official letterhead* from educators and/or professors should be enclosed or sent directly to the College of Architecture, Academic Programs Office. Place your individual profile and three letters of recommendation in a brown manila envelope.

4. *Portfolio of Work*

Enclose examples of creative work, which may include all types of academic and professional work. In the case of collaborative projects, the applicant's contribution should be clearly described. Please do not send originals. If you desire these materials to be returned to you, enclose appropriate packaging and postage.

5. *Transcripts*

Applying for the *Land –use Planning, Management, and Design Ph.D Program (LPMD)*, please submit copies of transcripts.
