1. *College of Architecture Application for Admission to the Graduate Program*

2. *Individual Profile*

Write a statement of how your life experiences, background information, and identity may add to the diversity of the College of Architecture. Limit of 250 words and must be double spaced. Place your individual profile and three letters of recommendation in a brown manila envelope.

3. *Letters of Recommendation*

Three letters of recommendation on *official letterhead* from educators and/or professors should be enclosed or sent directly to the College of Architecture, Academic Programs Office. Place your individual profile and three letters of recommendation in a brown manila envelope.

4. *Portfolio of Work*

Enclose examples of creative work, which may include all types of academic and professional work. In the case of collaborative projects, the applicant's contribution should be clearly described. Please do not send originals. If you desire these materials to be returned to you, enclose appropriate packaging and postage.

5. *LPMD only*

Applying for the *Land –use Planning, Management, and Design Ph.D Program (LPMD)*, please submit copies of transcripts. Also, please include a 2-3 page statement of your career goals and research interests and a sample of research writing (submit a maximum 5,000 word example of your research writing skills. This may be a research paper you have written for a class assignment or as an employee. This should include a citations, bibliography and footnotes. The submittal must be in English.)
